


On a hill far away stood an old rugged cross, the emblem of suffering and shame; and I love that old cross where the dearest and best for a world of lost sinners was slain.




In the beginning You alone made the world and it was perfect.

You created oscillating oceans, rushing rivers, and silent streams, all declaring Your glory.


You created flowers of every color You could dream of, giving many a perfume that is unmatched in their delight.


